IV. ELIGIBILITY

High School

Semester: All students must have a 2.0 grade point average and earned credit in four of five academic classes from the previous trimester in order to be eligible for the current trimester.

Weekly: All Students must be passing four of five academic classes during the current trimester.

Middle School

The Middle School policy is a weekly system. Students must have six of seven teachers sign their eligibility card before becoming eligible for competitions.

V. FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Each athlete is responsible for his/her athletic equipment issued to him or her by the coaching staff. If this equipment is lost, stolen, or carelessly damaged, the athlete will be held responsible for the cost to replace it.

VI. PARTICIPATION FEE
